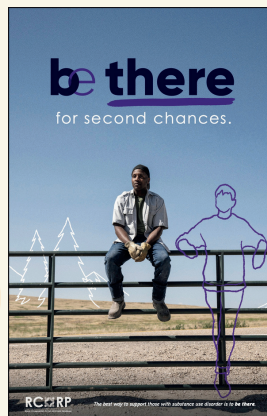

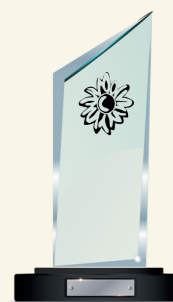

We are not a treatment provider. Our role is to support individuals seeking positive change by offering non-judgmental, safe spaces to explore treatment options. Through community health workers and peer support, we help individuals navigate available services, determine what might best meet their needs, and provide transportation assistance to and from treatment. Additionally, we offer private telehealth access to ensure confidential connections to care.
